
Reditus reports on developments concerning foreign currency receivables from Angolan public entities

Under the terms and for the purposes established in article 248-A of the Securities Exchange Code, Reditus, SGPS, SA hereby informs on credits receivable by its subsidiaries from Angolan public entities, amounting to approximately 50 million euros. This represents 84% of its Customer Receivables, 29% of its Assets and 157% of its Equity.

Such credits result from the supply of services, equipment and goods in the scope of technological projects initiated in 2009, of which the first billings took place in 2013. A total of approximately 9 million Euros was received in 2013, with no financial flows related to the projects having occurred since then.

The Board of Reditus believes that such credits will be received in Portugal, in Euros, over an estimated period of 24 to 30 months, whereby such payments are being negotiated within the credit *plafond* established in the *Portugal - Angola Credit Risk Protection Convention* for the export of goods, equipment and services, benefitting from credit insurance coverage by *COSEC - Companhia de Seguros de Créditos, SA*.
